

New rules of evidence in international arbitration

It is a widely accepted fact that contested claims must be proven in court before they can be granted. Also pursuant to the new art. 8.4 of the Civil Code, the party who believes they can take another party to court must prove the legal acts or facts which underlie such a claim.
